**EuroEyes (HKEx: 1846) Completed Its First Surgery Day
in Two New Clinics in Chengdu and Copenhagen**

EuroEyes International Eye Clinic Limited (“EuroEyes” or the “Company”, together with its subsidiaries, the “Group”, stock code: 1846), is pleased to announce that the Group completed its first surgery day in the new Chengdu clinic on March 29, and the first surgery day in the new Copenhagen clinic on March 28, both of which were a huge success.

The new Chengdu clinic in China is located close to Taikoo Li, the famous high-end commercial area, and is equipped with a floor area of 454.8 square meters. The Group believes that the Chengdu clinic will further enhance EuroEyes’ existing network of clinics in China, bringing synergy to its business development and accelerating the Group’s growth momentum in China. The new clinic is expected to achieve break-even in a [relatively] short period of time.

The newly opened flagship eye clinic in Denmark is located in Copenhagen’s Parken Stadium, one of the 12 host venues of the UEFA Euro 2021. The new flagship eye clinic, which will replace the existing premises, is designed to further strengthen EuroEyes’ leading position in the vision correction industry in Northern Europe and is expected to continue to grow in the future, thereby helping even more patients with glasses, reading glasses and contact lenses.

Dr. Jørn Slot Jørgensen, Founder, Chairman and CEO of EuroEyes said, “We are pleased to have had the first surgery days at our two new clinics this week. Looking ahead, EuroEyes will pay close attention to the market and actively capitalise on business opportunities arising from the growing awareness of vision care. We will continue to explore ideal locations for new clinics and further improve the utilization rate of the Group’s existing surgical centres. We are confident that this two-pronged strategy will create greater value for our shareholders and accelerate the Group’s overall business growth.”
